Bob: No man, sorry. Ask Roger.

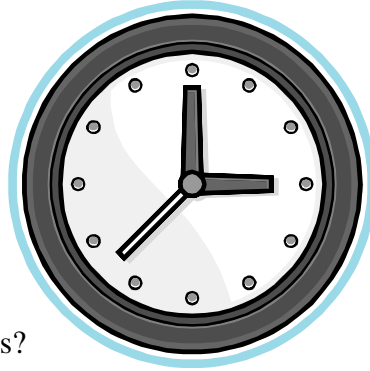
Julio: Okay. Hey Roger, do you know what time it is?
