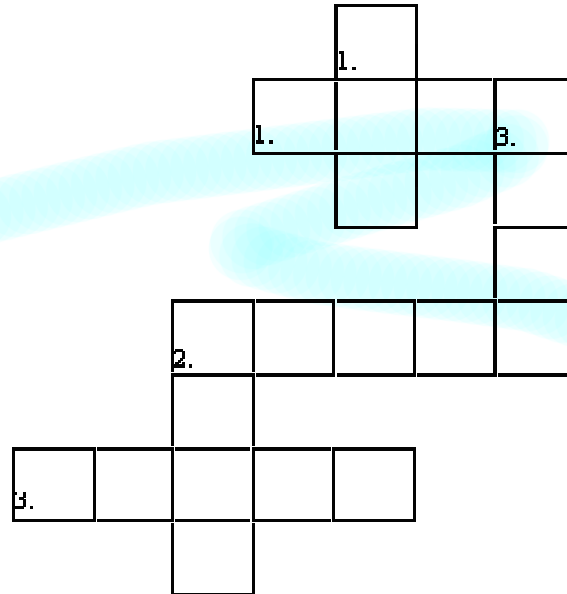


Crossword Puzzle – Verbs in Present Tense

Directions: use the clues below to fill in the crossword puzzle with the correct words.



Across:

1. This word means: *to use your legs to make your body leave the ground*. This word starts with the letter “J” and ends with the letter “P”. **J _ _ P**

2. You must do this to learn. This word starts with the letter “S” and ends with “Y”. **S _ _ _ Y**



3. This action is fun to do. You do it at parties and at night. You do it when music is playing. This word starts with the letter “D”. **D _ _ _ _**

Down:

1. You do this to move and to get exercise. It is faster than a walk. This word starts with the letter “R”. **R _ _**

2. This action is fun to do. You use your mouth and tongue to make pretty sounds. You usually do this when music. This word starts with the letter “S” and ends with “G”. **S _ _ G**

3. This is fun. You normally do it with your friends. This word starts with the letter “P” and ends with “Y”. **P _ _ _ Y**
