Answers and Explanations

1) **A**

A characteristic of a *dictator* is to be *controlling*. A characteristic of a *judge* is to be *impartial*, or unbiased. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

2) **C**

A *fireplace* is used to provide *heat*. A *meal* is used to provide *nourishment*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

3) **C**

Forfeit is a synonym of *surrender*. *Condemn* is a synonym of *criticize*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

4) **D**

Apathetic means uncaring. Thus, someone who is apathetic lacks *concern*. *Unbiased* means impartial or not prejudiced. Thus, someone who is unbiased lacks *prejudice*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

5) **B**

Real is the opposite of *imagined*. *Rigid*, or stiff, is the opposite of *flexible*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

6) **B**

War is a type of *conflict*. A *nightmare* is a type of *dream*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

7) **A**

Something that is *priceless* is very *valuable*. Something that is *cursed* is very *unlucky*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

8) **D**

Infamous means famous, especially for a bad reason. Thus, the opposite of infamous is *unknown*. The opposite of *modern* is *ancient*, or very old. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

9) **A**

A characteristic of a *hurricane* is to be *destructive*, or damaging. A *fad* is something that is popular for only a short time. Thus, a characteristic of a *fad* is to be *temporary*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

10) **C**

Opera is a genre of music. *Horror* is a genre of film. Therefore **(C)** is correct.
