## Answers and Explanations

1) **A**

Brothers and sisters have the same mother. Therefore, your brother is your mother's *son*. Choice **(A)** is correct.

**(B)** is incorrect because your brother is not your mother's *daughter*. Your mother's daughter is your sister, because brothers and sons are boys, but sisters and daughters are girls. A daughter is a girl, so she cannot be your brother.

**(C)** is incorrect because your brother is not your mother's *father*. Your mother's father is your grandfather.

**(D)** is incorrect because your brother is not your mother's *nephew*. Your mother's nephew is your cousin.

2) **A**

Wheels help cars, bicycles, trucks, and other vehicles to move. *Bicycles* have two wheels. Cars have *four* wheels. Choice **(A)** is correct.

**(B)** is incorrect because *trucks* do not have two wheels. They have anywhere from four to eighteen wheels.

**(C)** is incorrect because *buses* do not have two wheels, either. Like trucks, they have at least four wheels.

**(D)** is incorrect because most *boats* do not have wheels at all. They travel in the water, not on land, so they do not need wheels.

3) **C**

A *pharmacy* is a store where people can buy medicine. Stephen is sick, so his mother must go to buy medicine for him at the pharmacy. Choice **(C)** is correct.

**(A)** is incorrect because you do not buy medicine at a *farm*.

**(B)** is incorrect because you do not buy medicine at a *school*.

**(C)** is incorrect because you do not buy medicine at a *theater*.

4) **B**

A sibling can be a brother or a sister. Rita has two siblings. We know one of them is a sister, but the other one could be a brother or another sister. Because "sister" is not an answer choice, we must choose *brother*. Choice **(B)** is correct.

**(A)** is incorrect because a *cousin* is not a sibling.

(B) is incorrect because a *child* is not a sibling.

(D) is incorrect because a *husband* is not a sibling.

5) C

The *ocean* is the only answer choice that describes a place where people can swim. To get to the ocean, you go to the *beach*. Choice (C) is correct.

(A) is incorrect because you cannot swim in the *library*.

(B) is incorrect because you cannot swim in *trees*.

(D) is incorrect because you cannot swim in *snow*.

6) D

Your *uncle* is the brother of your mother or *father*. Therefore, it makes sense to say that my father's brother is my uncle. Choice (C) is correct.

(A) is incorrect because your *aunt's* brother is not your *wife*.

(B) is incorrect because your *grandmother's* brother is not your *nephew*.

(C) is incorrect because your *daughter's* brother is not your *cousin*.

7) C

Margo enforces the law, protects the citizens, and carries a gun to work. This describes the work of a *police officer*. Choice (C) is correct.

(A) is incorrect because this sentence does not describe the work of a *fire fighter*.

(B) is incorrect because this sentence does not describe the work of a *teacher*.

(D) is incorrect because this sentence does not describe the work of a *construction worker*.

8) A

In order to *run*, you must use your *legs*. Choice (C) is correct.

(B) is incorrect because you do not use your *hands* to *sleep*.

(C) is incorrect because you do not use your *mouth* to *move*.

(D) is incorrect because you do not use your *ears* to *breathe*.

9) D

The *father* of your mother is your *grandfather*. Choice (D) is correct.

**(A)** is incorrect because your *nephew* is not your mother's father. Your nephew is your aunt or uncle's son.

**(B)** is incorrect because your *uncle* is not your mother's father. Your uncle is your mother or father's brother.

**(C)** is incorrect because your *godmother* is not your mother's father. A godmother is a woman who sponsors a Christian child at baptism.

10) **D**

The question uses words like "my" and "me" to describe the children. This means that I am one of the children in the question. I am the child of my *mother*. Choice **(D)** is correct.

**(A)** is incorrect because my *stepsister* might have three children, but I cannot be one of their children. I am only the child of my mother and my father.

**(B)** is incorrect because my *son* might have three children, but I cannot be one of their children. I am only the child of my mother and my father.

**(C)** is incorrect because my *friend* might have three children, but I cannot be one of their children. I am only the child of my mother and my father.
