A) almanac

1) A reference work (often in several volumes) containing articles on various topics (often arranged in alphabetical order) dealing with the entire range of human knowledge or with some particular specialty

B) autobiography

2) A book containing recipes and instructions for cooking

C) biography

3) An annual publication containing a calendar for the coming year, the times of such events and phenomena as anniversaries, sunrises and sunsets, phases of the moon, tides, etc., and other statistical information and related topics

D) cookbook

E) dictionary

4) A dictionary of synonyms and antonyms

F) encyclopedia

5) Literature that is based on fact

G) fiction

6) Literature that is a work of the imagination and is not necessarily based on fact

H) non-fiction

7) A book containing a selection of the words of a language, usually arranged alphabetically, giving information about their meanings, pronunciations, etymologies, inflected forms, etc.

8) A written account of another person's life

9) A history of a person's life written or told by that person
