

## Past Tense Subject / Verb Agreement

Use the following structure to form subject – verb agreement in the past tense.

Subject + [Verb with “ed” ending]

Remember, some verbs have an irregular conjugation in the past tense!

The verb “to be” has an irregular conjugation in the past tense:

I / he / she / it	[was]
you / we / they	[were]

- 10) The students (studied, studies) before the test yesterday.
