## Using the Verb "To be"

Choose the correct form of the verb "To be" in future tense.

Note: There are two ways to use the future tense with "to be."

1) You may use: [form of the to be][going to be]

Example: Pedro (be) is going to be in the school play this year.
Example: Sarah (be) was going to be in the school play this year, but she got sick and could not come to school.
2) You may use: [will][be]

Example: Dad and I will be at the show tonight. We will see you there!
*For more on the difference between "going to" and "will," please refer to our worksheet titled, "Using going to and will."
