## Answers and Explanations

1) **D**

Someone who is *weak* lacks *strength*. Someone who is *lost* lacks *direction*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

2) **A**

A *hurricane* is a type of *storm*. A *table* is a type of *furniture*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

3) **B**

A characteristic of a *suit* is to be *formal*. A characteristic of a *coat* is to be *warm*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

4) **C**

*Hungry* is the opposite of *full*. *Evil* is the opposite of *good*. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

5) **B**

A *lap* is part of a *race*. An *act* is part of a *play*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.

6) **D**

A *hamburger* is a type of *sandwich*. A *pretzel* is a type of *snack*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

7) **A**

*Meat* comes from *animals*. *Paper* comes from *trees*. Therefore **(A)** is correct.

8) **D**

By definition, someone who is *angry* is also *mad*. By definition, someone who is *nice* is also *kind*. Therefore **(D)** is correct.

9) **C**

The purpose of a *commercial* is to *advertise* a product. The purpose of a *comedy* is to *entertain* an audience. Therefore **(C)** is correct.

10) **B**

*Volleyball* is a type of *sport*. A *runner* is a type of *athlete*. Therefore **(B)** is correct.
